To the Officers of the ICS Northeast Tribe,

This action of the Northeast Tribe Chief is unacceptable. I request an immediate meeting with the Tribe Officers. I had written several times about the election abuses of CJ Stumpf. You had not properly addressed them. Now Stumpf, fearing an election defeat, has cancelled the election, only five days before the close, with no notice to the candidates.

Stumpf is in her third year as Tribe Rep and Chief. She was elected for a one-year term in 2015. Her term expired in 2016. Yet, you have allowed her to remain in that position, without an election. I have been pushing for a Tribe election for quite some time. Finally, after a discussion with Pete Morse this past summer, an election was underway. The nomination and election process was fraught with election improprieties and abuses by Stumpf. Although I registered some of my complaints with the tribe officers, nothing was done. I decided to ignore the abuses, and continue my campaign.

With only five days remaining in the voting period, and perhaps sensing a likely defeat (possibly by a wide margin), Stumpf cancelled the election. Further, she postponed the election until next summer (2018). Thereby, appointing herself Tribe Chief and Rep for yet another year. Many of Stumpf's reasons for the cancellation are fabrications and excuses. Throughout the nomination and election period, Stumpf ran an unethical (dirty) campaign, and has overtly abused her position as Tribe Chief to advance her personal election campaign.

Nonetheless, I restrained myself from making a fuss about Stumpf's abuses, and continued my election campaign. Now, Stumpf has cancelled the election and appointed herself Chief and Rep for another year. Again, this is unethical and unacceptable.

Hence, I request the following:

1. An immediate meeting with the Tribe Officers
2. An immediate disposition as to Stumpf's continued service as Tribe Chief and Rep
3. Immediate notice be given to the ICS Secretary, as to that disposition.
4. An immediate interim replacement of Stumpf by Assistant Tribe Chief, Ron Ward, until such time as a permanent solution is implemented.

Finally, per my attorney, I must advise the Tribe officers to maintain and preserve all documents, records,

correspondence, and nomination and election data.

Please advise me promptly with your response, as time is of the essence.
