I have asked elections committee chair Bill Cunniff to take the lead in completing our suspended 2018 elections.

The main remaining steps to my knowledge are:

1. A 1st class mailing to those who have not yet responded.
2. Paper balloting, marked with a unique ID per eligible voter.

Step 1 is per Kansas law

Step 2 is per the July 2018 northeast meeting and vote of the tribe at Parlin

The PO box retained by the Judge remains available for our balloting as I believe it was purchased for a full year.

This is the completion of our 2018 elections, contested by Shiloh when he sent his "contesting and therefore suspending" email in July 2018. Therefore everyone eligible to vote in July 2018 remains eligible.

I would appreciate your giving Bill your full support in this effort. It is, apart from our type support efforts, our top priority, and is extremely time sensitive.

There is also an urgent need to get as much participation as possible. Bill feels we need unprecedented participation - at least 150 people - voting.

Bill is requesting a conference call Weds 8pm for a status update and task allocation and any thoughts that you might have that will ensure success. Please reply/all with your ability to participate. Thursday 8pm is backup.

I have already passed on to Bill, Ron and Lynn's Ward's willingness to assist with the mailings.

Aside from the current treasury we have several hundred dollars in donations of money and stamps that are available, which should be sufficient to cover the mailings.

Looking forward to a successful result reached via a fair and transparent process.
