This report updates the Northeast Tribe activities and status since the last report dated March 31, 1992. This is my last report as Tribe Chief as new officers have been elected as noted below.

Three successful flyins have been held since the last report. They were:

April 3	Washington, DC	Host: Allen Rothenberg
May 15	New Hope, PA	Host: Dan Emerson
June 12	Norfolk, VA	Host: Bill Jackson

A flyin is scheduled for October 2 at Nantucket, MA hosted by Keith Krewson, and Dave Hess is working on a schedule for the coming year.

The Norfolk flyin featured, among other things, ground and flight training by Larry Larkin which proved most successful. The ground school was divided into a 4 hour basic section which was part of the flyin registration and an optional 12 hour section. Additionally, Larry gave flight instruction and review to those so opting. The cost was \$15 for the basic section, \$120 for the optional ground section and \$200 for the flight instruction. Attendance was approximately 30 for the basic section, 13 for the optional ground school, and 9 for the flight instruction.

Simultaneously with Larkin's basic section, Eric Thompson gave a 4 hour Comanche Companion Flyer ground school, the \$15 for which was part of the flyin registration fee. This course was well received by the 16 attendees.

The Tribe held its annual business meeting on June 13 at which it elected the following officers for 1992-93:

Treasurer; Ted Mauger, ICS 6065, South Berwick, Maine.

The Tribe also voted to incorporate as a membership, non-stock, non-profit corporation in the State of Kansas with the expenses borne by ICS. Initially, the Tribe will use the service of an agent recommended by ICS. Our initial board of directors are the three newly-elected officers. The tribe also adopted its first set of bylaws which are patterned after that suggested by ICS.

The Tribe's 1997 convention committee reported that it had received several site suggestions. Ted Mauger reported that the Tribe's net worth is \$6206.23 as of June 10, 1992.

The Tribe published one newsletter during the year in April, 1992.
